Abstract

The bachelor thesis deals with relationships between physicians and nurses. In the theoretical part the author describes relations and their development in general. It deals with ethical aspects of the profession of nurse and physician, partially describes gender issues of both professions. It also characterizes the surgical workplace and its specifics. The final part introduces the individual generations: the oldest Generation Baby Boomers, Generation X, Generation Y and the youngest Generation Z, which is now entering the labor market.

The empirical part examines working relationships and cooperation of both professions in the surgical department. Each statement is evaluated as a whole and then assessed by individual generations.
