

This work called The Credit - Saving Institute in Hradec Králové (in years 1868-1914) discuss the oldest Czech national bank during the period of the end of Austro-Hungarian monarchy. This bank was a prototype of the national Czech bank directing its business operations to the region of Eastern Bohemia.

In this paper I wanted to focus on the problems of bank's management and business activities. The aim of this work is the analytical study of these key aspects of bank's development.

The Credit - Saving Institute in Hradec Králové was formed in provincial center of Eastern Bohemia, Hradec Králové, and with this town the bank kept close connection. These close connections found expressions in the structure of the bank's management, which majority was formed by industrialists from the surrounding of Hradec Králové, who at the same time were mostly active members of the municipality.
