

Abstract

The topic of this rigorous work is neighborhood rights and their protection. The aim of this work is to subject the legal regulation of neighbourhood rights to legal assessment with a focus on ways in which neighborhood rights can be easily enforced. In each chapter of this work, the legal regulation of neighborhood rights is partially compared with the legal regulation of neighborhood rights in Germany.
