

This work aims to map the occurrence and development of infectious occupational diseases (INZP) in 2001-2006 and the possibilities of prevention in selected INZP listed in the list of diseases occupational (NZP) under 1, ie interhumánním transmission.

Occupational disease is a disease listed in the List of Occupational Diseases, which is part of Government Regulation No. 290/1995 Coll. The disease referred to in this list are divided into six chapters. Infectious and parasitic diseases are given in Chapter V. It is divided into three items.

First transmitted diseases and infestations. They are included here with interhumánním disease transmission.

Second Diseases transmitted from animals to humans either directly or through ports.

Diseases listed in items 1 and 2 occur at work, at which it is shown to the risk of infection.

3rd Tropical Infectious and parasitic diseases, arising from work in epidemiologically difficult areas with risk of infection
