**Course of defence:** The student presented her thesis focusing on the relationship between

trade with China, and export diversification and economic complexity, on the example of South Africa and Pakistan. In her presentation she explained the motivation of her analysis and the choice of her focus on the two countries. After the presentation, the

rapporteur summarized the advisor and the opponent reports,

focusing on the critical questions regarding the specification of the regression model, the inclusion of both value of trade and share of trade with China, the selection of existing literature for the literature review, the contribution of the thesis to the existing literature, and the difference between correlation and causality. Also, the student was asked to explain how it can happen in international trade that countries end up in a trap by trading with a much stronger trading

partner. The student responded very well to the raised questions and manifested her knowledge of the international trade issues in general. After a long discussion, taking into account the student's good peformance during the defense, the committee concluded that the thesis still, albeit at a margin, fulfills the requirements for a bachelor

thesis at the IES, and decided on grade E.
