comments raised in the advisor's and opponent's reports, namely about claimed causality, possible presence of hidden variables, which other methods could be used, the potential effects of including nondemocratic countries in the sample and about the relationship between cultural differences and effectiveness of anti-covid measures. These questions were answered satisfactorily. The

committee raised additional questions about effects of governmental

interventions as a variable and the nature and importance of

hydroxychlorine molecule which appears as a factor in the analysis. Ultimately, taking into account the opinion of the opponent, and

balancing the strengths and the

weaknesses of the thesis, the committee decided on the grade C.
