Course of defence:	The student started the defense with a well-prepared presentation, covering the motivation for the thesis, the existing literature, the methodology used (fixed effects panel data model), and the main conclusions. The advisor's and opponent's reports raised several questions, namely through which means could the Chinese central bank decrease the perceived level of monetary policy uncertainty, whether a change in the monetary policy regime in China towards a more standard regime would result in increase or decrease monetary policy uncertainty, which factors not included in the model could influence R&D investments, and about the limitations of the conducted empirical analysis for China with market economy containing some elements that are controlled by the central government. The student responded to them in a rather competent way. The committee raised a few additional questions which were answered satisfactorily. All in all, the committee appreciated the very good quality of the thesis and decided on grade B.
