Course of defence: [in person] The student presented the thesis defence beginning with

the reviewer's criticisms, focusing on events that trigger the

relevance of the topic.

CU Committee: Dr Tesař and Dr Salamon invite the student to focus on the most serious criticisms rather than deeply elaborate on the

conceptual definitions such as 'backsliding'.

The student defends the event's selection and moves into the

supervisor's critique.

CÛ Committee: Dr Salamon reminds the student about the time limit when defending the thesis so that he is more concise towards the most serious criticism, for instance, the low number of references

used in the text.

The student replies he wanted to have more historical content, given

the literature availability.

CU Committee: Dr Baxa asks about the value, or the contribution to academia, given the vast quantity of literature available on the topic

(e.g. Google Scholar).

The student replies the topic is a matter of current affairs.

CU Committee: Dr Salamon turns the conversation towards the main conclusion of the text.

The student briefly mentions his main conclusion.

CU Commitee: Dr Tesař highlights the difference between an opinion paper and an academic paper and his perception that the text is rather an opinion turned into a thesis. Then asks about the number

of references included which have been peer-reviewed.

The student claims there were some strong limitations to elaborating

the thesis.

CU Committee: Dr Tesař asks about using Wikipedia as a source in

the text.

The student defends the use of Wikipedia as a resource. CU Committee: Dr Baxa turns the discussion towards the perception in Turkiye towards the West, as suggested by one of the reviewers. The student replies by saying he consulted MetroPOLL within a specific period and how these results were assessed in the text. No further questions from the Committee.
