The aim of the diploma thesis is to analyze and compare information needs and information behavior of primary school teachers during the Covid-19 pandemic. The theoretical part of the thesis will focus on information behavior of teachers and will describe the development of anti-epidemic measures in education during the coronavirus pandemic. The practical part will be based on a combination of questionnaires, depth interviews and their subsequent evaluation. The thesis will focus on the information behavior of teachers, processing use of information, information sources, evaluation of the credibility of the information sought by teachers in preparation for teaching, in teaching itself and in self-education. The thesis also aims to find out how teachers themselves evaluate information and information sources of pupils in reports and school work in the period before the pandemic and then during it.

Diploma thesis will be prepared according to valid inner regulations of Faculty of Arts, Charles University and further guidelines and normative documents.
