## Short summary

The submitted thesis examines the influence of social media and news sentiment on firms' stock prices in the gaming industry. The author collected data from Twitter and news headlines, aggregated them into daily sentiment measures, and used them as input for analysis of selected companies' returns and volatility series. The empirical analysis involved a vector autoregression model and testing Granger causality. The results of the analysis do not reveal significant differences between the gaming and non-gaming industries, although some slight differences were present.

## Contribution

The presented thesis contributes to the literature studying the use of investor sentiment for asset pricing. To me, the main contribution of the thesis is the chosen industry, the gaming industry, as it was not studied "heavily" before. Although the time span of several months is not the ideal one, and the longer sample would be preferred, the author was still able to obtain results that have certain value added.

## Methods

The methods used in the thesis, such as GARCH or vector autoregression, are adequate for the IES master thesis. The methods are described in a concise manner, applied correctly, and the assumptions, such as stationarity, have been tested. The results of the analysis are discussed in detail.

## Literature

The submitted thesis contains an adequate literature review, and all the papers mentioned in the thesis are highly relevant to the topic. The author shows a good knowledge of the literature, works with it properly and explains all the concepts used throughout the thesis in a concise manner.

## Manuscript form

The author considered the majority of my comments on the previous version of the text; however, due to the time constraints, I had not seen some chapters before the thesis was submitted. Overall, the submitted thesis is nicely written and reads well, and I have just a few comments regarding the structure/format. It would be nice to have at least a brief description of results in the Introduction; the tables should have the same format throughout the whole thesis; the figures should be of the same size if they are displaying the same information; in the text of chapter 6 the author refers to tables from chapter 5, i.e., wrong numbering of tables; the visual representation of some tables such as 6.5 deserves to be improved, etc.

## Overall evaluation and suggested questions for the discussion during the defense

Overall, I think that the presented thesis is a nice empirical exercise applied to the nonstandard industry sector. Although the time span for analysis is rather short, the results are valid and still present possible guidelines for investors considering their investment based on sentiment analysis. The student should explain the motivation for choosing the nonstandard gaming industry during the defence.

In my view, the thesis fulfills the requirements for a master thesis at IES, Faculty of Social Sciences, Charles University, I recommend it for the defense and suggest a grade B. The results of the Turnitin analysis do not indicate significant text similarity with other available sources.
