

Abstract (in English):

This bachelor thesis is divided into a theoretical and a practical part. In its theoretical part, it deals mainly with the verb, more precisely with non-finite verb forms and their function in subordinate implicit clauses. The main topic of this thesis is then the absolute participle, which is analyzed in the practical part based on the parallel corpus InterCorp. The aim of this thesis is to present a comprehensive view of non-finite verb forms, especially the absolute participle and the typology of its Czech translation counterparts with sufficient precision.
