**Abstract** 

After military invasion of Ukraine in 2022, Russian Hybrid Warfare went from being a

convenient 'bogeyman' of Russian military strategy interpretation, to a conceptual pariah of

Western political and strategic discourse. This was not, however the case in Russia, where,

admittedly, gibridnaya voyna transformed into the phase of 'rationalisation propaganda' in an

attempt justify Kremlin's self-made threat perception. This study aims to fill the research gap

in Western contemporary analysis of *gibridnaya voyna* by conducting an exploratory research

to see if there have been any changes in the interpretation and the use of gibridnaya voyna in

Russian military scholarship after Russia's military invasion of Ukraine. The study will

demonstrate that although conceptual understanding of the term remains the same, its

interpretation in military and linguistic (buzzwords) domains experienced significant changes.
