

**Abstract (in English):**

In this work, the author deals with the topic of the Municipal chronicle of the municipality of Bečváry from 1948 to 1980. Reconstruction of the missing part (1965-1978). The work is divided into two parts, a general part and a research part. The general part contains 6 chapters, the research part 34 chapters. After the preface and introduction, the author describes the available archival sources and literature. The third chapter deals with municipal chronicles as a historical source in the examined period. Within this chapter, an explanation of the relevant up-to-date treatment of the topic of municipal chronicling in the examined period (1948-1980) is included. The fourth chapter contains an explanation of the development of the legal regulation of municipal chronicles, while the emphasis was placed on the changes in the examined period. The fifth chapter deals with changes in territorial self-government after 1945. The sixth chapter contains an explanation of the history of the Bečváry village before 1948. The research part contains chapters dealing with the Bečváry Memorial Book itself. The relevant passages are devoted to individual chroniclers who worked in Bečvár in the period under review, and the state of the village at the beginning of the period under review. Subsequently, external and internal criticism of the Bečváry Memorial Book as a historical source is carried out. Within the framework of internal criticism, individual areas of matters are analyzed, which are usually included in entries in municipal chronicles. The author mainly deals with, for example, the issue of the district of the village, as well as registration and electoral matters, municipal officials, census, construction matters, education, trades and agriculture. The next chapters contain the edition of the annual records from 1949 to 1964. They are followed by chapters containing reconstructed records from 1964 to 1978, as no chronicle was kept at all during this period. The research part also includes editions of records from 1979 and 1980, and an editorial note. The diploma thesis is further complemented by a pictorial appendix, a list of used literature and sources, a list of images and abbreviations. In the work, the author follows his previous bachelor's thesis, which dealt with the period between 1923 and 1948. The reconstruction is based on other chronicles, especially the school chronicle, the parish chronicle of the Drahobudice rectory, and also the BSP chronicle. The reconstruction is carried out within the limits of the GDPR regulation and legal regulation of personal data processing. Regional and nationwide periodicals are also used for the reconstruction.
