Abstract

With the rapid development of forensic anthropology, there is a growing discussions about its professionalization and standardization are increasing. The aim of this bachelor thesis is to summarize the current state of forensic anthropology and provide an overview of the factors influencing the formation of this discipline. Attention is given to standardizing procedures, options for certifying practiting experts, and accrediting bodies. Furthermore, the current recomendations for methods of estimating sex and age-at-death in skeletal remains of adult individuals are discussed, along with a summary of the methods actually used by practicing experts.
