Short summary

This thesis examines the price determinants of rum and explores its potential as an investment asset. Martin collects a unique dataset on rum and performs a unique analysis in two parts: hedonic analysis and repeated sales regression. Martin finds that rum's age and reputation have the greatest impact on rum prices and hence are strong determinants of price. In short, the thesis is a very good example of a solid and well-done piece of work with a clear economic question, in-depth analysis and novel conclusions that could be of potential interest to a wider audience.

Contribution

With many alternative assets, such as spirits, art or even luxury watches, becoming more and more popular with investors, the literature on alternative investments is growing. This thesis makes a significant contribution to this literature through a novel study of the factors that influence rum pricing and the study of rum as a potential investment asset. The thesis is one of the first to look at rum from an alternative investment perspective, Martin has worked consistently and carefully to obtain a representative sample of data, and after careful statistical analysis has come to some interesting conclusions.

Methods

The thesis uses appropriate statistical methods for analysis, based on hedonic analysis and repeated sales regression, which Martin suggested for analysis after several consultations. I must emphasise that the collection, cleaning and preparation of the dataset itself was an issue that Martin dealt with in a professional manner.

Literature

The author uses all relevant literature correctly, introduces the literature well and discusses all relevant sources in sufficient detail.

Manuscript form

The thesis is very nicely and logically written and links the findings well to the existing literature. The introduction and motivation are clear and the reader can see that the author has put a lot of care into the text. Martin has worked consistently on the results over a long period of time and we have discussed the results and the text regularly throughout the year.
