| Course of the examination:  | The author prepared nice 10-minutes presentation where she<br>summarized her topic, literature review, used method, findings and<br>limitation including suggestions for future research. Both reviewers<br>appreciated the choice of topic, the research was appropriately<br>designed and well-implemented, analysis was comprehensive with<br>interesting findings. However, both of the reviewers pointed out that<br>theoretical framework lacks depth, they also suggested better overall<br>structure. According to the opponent, the outdated sources (and lack<br>of photojournalism studies) also weaken the discussion and<br>conclusion. She also suggested to go deeper within the thematic<br>analysis. However, analysis was comprehensive with interesting<br>findings. During the defence, the author acknowledged missing<br>photojournalism studies, a bit chaotic structure, she also explained<br>more the process of analysis and method. Taking into consideration<br>the defence, the author was graded with B. |
