

**Abstract:**

This bachelor thesis examines double negation in Czech expressed by repeating the negative particle *ne-* twice in immediate succession. For the research, we aimed to find as many examples of words with this type of double negation as possible, gathering material from selected Czech dictionaries, written language corpora, the *Lexical database of humanistic and baroque Czech* and the *Kramerijs* digital library (version 5). After collecting the excerpts we conducted a quantitative analysis according to individual parts of speech, focusing furthermore on the semantics of double negation and taking into account competing means of double negation expressed by two successive negative particles. Particular attention is paid to the development of this type of negation in biblical translation where its occurrences in Old or Early Modern Czech translations have been detected. Finally, we summarized the results of the research and offered possible starting points for further research.
