Abstract

This bachelor's thesis examines the foreign policy of People's Republic of China in the South China sea region and conducts a comparative analysis of international documents and its obligations to which China has committed itself and the specific actions of Chinese foreign policy in this region. In the main part of this thesis the most relevant international documents accepted by China are described in detail. After that the thesis is focused on the development of Chinese foreign policy, the importance of South China sea, and on the actual comparison itself. In the final part the thesis answers research questions and comes into a conclusion that China's actions in the area of South China Sea are not in line with the accepted documents to which China has committed itself.
