ABSTRACT

Anna Čermáková's professional development portfolio contains 10 mandatory sections, each with a required structure. All these sections map out the author's professional and academic development. Her employment in an after-school program at an alternative-focused school and the related topics are interwoven throughout the work - an essay on the topic of Freedom And Rules In Education discusses the challenging definition of the term "leisurely upbringing" and the issues associated with this approach, while in the book outline, the author examines the work of one of the key figures in alternative pedagogy, Maria Montessori, in "From Childhood to Adolescence."
