**ABSTRACT** 

Tittle: The Organization of Secondary School Skiing Training Course

**Objective:** The objective of this bachelor thesis is to compare the organization of ski courses

at selected state and private grammar schools in the Czech Republic.

Methods: The data for the processing of the thesis were obtained in the form of a survey at

randomly selected grammar schools from all over the Czech Republic. The survey consisted of

closed and open questions, in which respondents were asked how ski courses take place at the

addressed schools. There were 46 grammar schools participated in the survey.

Results: The survey shows that private grammar schools organize ski training courses abroad

more often than state grammar schools and accept more external instructors. On the other hand,

state grammar schools more often have ski equipment available being able to lend to their

pupils. A very positive result was brought by questions about safety during ski courses in the

survey, where all the surveyed schools stated that they instruct their pupils about safety and

require them to wear at least a ski helmet.
