

ABSTRACT

This bachelor thesis aims to analyse the ongoing process of equalisation of homosexual unions and the LGBT+ community in Czech society. It is a compilation thesis which maps the development of the decriminalization of homosexuality in the Czech lands and the first emancipatory efforts of the homosexual minority. It also closely examines the struggle for equal rights and the emergence of the question of registered partnership in the political discourse as well as the influence of various organizations that indirectly contributed to the change of status quo. Finally, the passing of the Civil Partnership Act, which represents the latest major step in the fight for equal rights for same-sex unions and marriages.
