After providing the motivation for the chosen topic, she presented a literature review focused on explaining the details of hybrid crowdfunding, introduced the methods, explained the baseline BDM model and its extension, and the results of the analysis. The committee members then discussed with the student how her analysis actually relates to art and Europe, and whether her results would still hold if we take into account that consumers might actually have more complicated utility functions and decide to fund some projects for reasons other than receiving the reward or as an investment.
