

Abstract

This thesis deals with the occurrence of non-literal linguistic devices in the speeches of radio presenters. The aim of this thesis is to identify and analyse the ungrammatical language offences committed by the presenters of the three most listened radio stations in the Czech Republic, namely Czech Radio Radiožurnál, Radio Impuls and Europe 2. Ungrammatical linguistic expressions are examined at the lexical, morphological, syntactic and phonological levels. Apart from unwritten means, the thesis also examines colloquial expressions and linguistic turns of phrase inappropriate for radio. The theoretical part is devoted to the stratification of the Czech language, the characteristics of spoken Czech, radio broadcasting and the language used in it.
