

Abstract

The bachelor's thesis deals with the topic of tripsitting in the Czech Republic. Tripsitting is a relatively new and controversial topic in the Czech Republic. The bachelor's thesis aims to identify the different rhetorical frameworks of the individual actors of the drug policy of the Czech Republic. Subsequently, it examines what their values and beliefs are and, last but not least, how their interpretation of tripsitting is influenced by the current legal framework of the Czech Republic. As a theoretical support for achieving the goals of the bachelor's thesis, the author used the analysis of frameworks according to theorists and Schön.

The author supplemented the analysis of the frameworks with the identification of topics that are associated with the topic of tripsitting. The author identified individual sponsors, problems of individual frameworks, their causes, affected parties, moral and ethical judgments, public political consequences and a proposal for possible solutions based on the analysis of the frameworks. Three main frameworks were identified in the thesis: the harm reduction framework, the absolute abstinence framework and the professional use and research framework. The analytical part of the thesis is based on data obtained from a total of 8 semi-structured interviews.
