

This thesis is about adolescent Ukrainian war refugees fleeing to the Czech Republic from the Russian invasion in their home country. The main objective is to identify the most common problems and challenges of integration of these adolescent Ukrainians, with a focus on educational policy. A secondary objective is to reveal the shortcomings of educational policy, in relation to the target group. The introduction introduces the reader to the research problem and the existing knowledge about it. The theories that are applied to the research topic are then presented. The problems of integration of these adolescents are examined in the context of a theory dealing with the integration of the individual into society, but also in the context of theories dealing with the development of the individual where the impact of migration and integration on them is examined. The author of the thesis describes related public policy documents. The research problem is examined in an expert survey with experts who work directly or indirectly with the target group. This investigation, in conjunction with the theoretical anchoring, provides detailed data through which the research questions are answered, thus fulfilling both objectives of this thesis.
