

Annotation

The thesis presents and compares different types of available sources that can provide information about the social organization of the household at the turn of the Middle Ages and the modern era in the house on Wenceslas Square No. 837/II in Prague. The thesis will present and describe a range of possible procedures that have been used to reconstruct the everyday life of a medieval and early modern household within the Kingdom of Bohemia, with an emphasis on the material culture of the early modern period and the Czech Renaissance and its possible interpretations. Furthermore, thesis analyses the relationship between house and household and compares their period variants from the point of view of archaeology. The researched written sources as well as archaeological finds, obtained during the excavation of the well of the house, place the work in a complex cultural-anthropological framework of knowledge and thus paint a picture of the everyday life of a town house.
