

Abstract

The aim of this thesis is to summarize the results of the existing research on the crusade against the Hussites, which took place in the summer of 1427. To do so, it uses secondary sources of domestic and foreign authors, which it compares and shows the differences and changes in the perception not only of this particular crusade, but also of the phenomenon of crusades against the Hussites in the context of the European crusading movement of the 15th century. At the same time, it places the crusade against the Hussites of 1427 among other anti-Hussite crusades and defines its specifics. The thesis also includes sources which show how differently the representatives of the opposing sides perceived the ongoing events.
