

ABSTRACT

The bachelor's thesis systematically examines the issue of domestic violence with a focus on homeless women. The objective of this study is to conduct an analysis of factors contributing to domestic violence affecting women without shelter. This analysis is structured into three key areas. The first area involves identifying the specifics of domestic violence in the context of homelessness. The second area focuses on assessing the needs of the victims themselves, while the third area is dedicated to mapping the existing system of social services provided for this target group, with an emphasis on the role of social workers. Additionally, this thesis aims to draw attention to the insufficient grounding of the issue of domestic violence among individuals without shelter, as the specific characteristics of the problem deviate from traditional definitions of the phenomenon of domestic violence.
