according to him, the theoretical part lacks some concepts. But the analytical part is very well prepared. He proposed grading B or C. Jan Miessler, as an opponent, appreciated the thesis with no formal

problems. The scope of research and chosen methods were

appropriate. However, he mentioned some objections (in some parts, the thesis could be more detailed, mainly in the analysis - it is rather more descriptive and superficial). Chih Yun Chen then discussed all

of the proposed questions.
