The student presented the thesis clearly and with confidence. Course of the examination:

> managing time well, though the presentation could have been more polished. The talk covered key elements, including the details of a very large dataset, the use of Fixed Effects (FE) and Random Effects (RE) estimation methodologies for a logistic regression structure, and the impact of initial conditions. Special focus was given to the effect of the COVID crisis on state dependence and endogeneity issues.

The presentation concluded with a summary of the thesis'

contributions.

Clarifying questions included whether the data used qualifies as a longitudinal study, the issue of reverse causality, and geographical

specifics. The student answered all questions very well,

demonstrating a strong grasp of the material.

The committee noted that while the topic was not entirely original, the student managed to handle the issue of causal interpretation well, despite a somewhat vague contribution above the many variables used. Overall, the performance was solid, resulting in a grade of B,

balancing the suggestion of both reports.
