Course of the examination: Jay-vee Marasigan Pangan presented his thesis, Start Them Young: The Influence of Education and Digital Transformation on Student Publications' Practices and Reportage in the Philippines. First, he introduced the theoretical framework, RQ, and then continued with methodology. After that, he presented the results of his study and concluded with a discussion and limits. His supervisor, Christine Trültzsch-Wijnen, mentioned that changes in methodology caused RQ to not be appropriately focused, and her objections were focused mainly on superficial theoretical background. However, she also mentioned the qualities of the thesis, such as the good analysis of quantitative and qualitative data. She proposed to grade D. František Géla, as an opponent, appreciated the analysis itself and also eg. coding by to coders. However, he also mentioned some objections, e.g., using secondary literature and sticking to the original research intention. Jay-vee Marasigan Pangan then answered all the proposed questions.
