The author submits an original and up-to-date diploma thesis for defense, which is dedicated to an important geopolitical topic, which is the phenomenon of water security. Specifically, in her research, she focused on the comparison of two important watercourses, or regimes that are linked to these watercourses - the Mekong and the Brahmaputra.
