

Abstract: This thesis deals with the life and career of Prince Bořivoj II of Přemyslid dynasty, who ruled the Czech principality between 1100 and 1107 and then again between 1117 and 1120. Also, his depiction in Czech, Polish and German sources, and the subsequent comparison of these sources. Thesis also deals with the issue of the unsuccessful Přemyslid monarchs, among whom is Bořivoj II. counted. The thesis also deals with the relations between Bořivoj and his brothers and tries to interpret the decisions and actions taken by Bořivoj and other important personalities during his life and reign.
