Course of the examination: [in person] The student presented her thesis defence by explaining

her academic and personal motivations to examine the narratives

behind Russia Today in Spanish. She then explains her

methodological choices to analyse the corpus of 667 articles using Sketch Engine. She then illustrated the main findings in terms of main narratives and how they resonate with Latin America with an

understanding of the context behind each narrative.

CU Committee: Dr Kofroñ goes though the supervisor's assessment highlighting the positive aspects, but mentioning the limitation of the timeframe used in the study. Dr Dobos concurs the timeframe

configures a limitation, especially because it is not explained in the

text.

Dr Kofroñ asks the student to elaborate on why that timeframe and the student explains the limitation was given by the search engine. Dr Kofroñ mentions the importance of including an appendix that includes the list of articles used in the study, precisely preventing the search engine limitation and aiming for replicability of external

readers.

Dr Kofroñ mentions it should be desirable to include a more technical explanation of how the software used works either in the methodological section or as an appendix, which helps the study's

robustness.
