Abstract

The bachelor thesis focused on processing of part of the collection of medieval pottery from the medieval village Spindelbach, that was obtained during an archaeological excavation in the 2011. The beginning of this thesis is an introduction of the site, archaeological surveys that were done here and summarises literature, that relates to the site. Next part includes an analysis of the field situation of the site, its pottery collection and its assessment. Further is introduced another six medieval sites, that are compared to Spindelbach. The last part valuates the site and asked questions.
