## ABSTRACT

This bachelor's thesis deals with the development of citizenship of the German population in Czechoslovakia throughout the state's existence. The emphasis is placed on key events and political decisions that influenced the granting, loss, or revocation of citizenship to individuals identifying with the German nationality. Methodologically, the thesis combines the analysis of historical sources (including documents from my family archive) with the interpretation of legislative measures. The aim of this thesis is to provide a more comprehensive view of the relationship between the German population and the Czechoslovak state, contribute to a better understanding of historical contexts, and the formation of national identity in Czechoslovakia.
