Abstract:

This bachelor thesis focuses on the usage of forms of the Czech pluralia tantum nouns that belong to the declension types 'hrad' and 'žena'. As a result of corpus analysis, the thesis aims to determine the distribution of the forms, considering the frequency of a certain word with its "regular" case suffix compared to its frequency with the case suffix borrowed from the paradigm of the other grammatical gender. The thesis is concluded by formulating the general tendencies that are found in the forms of pluralia tantum nouns and by questioning the possible factors in this regard.
