## Abstract

In this thesis, I analyzed the adaptation process of Ukrainian children from the perspective of their parents. Through my research, I identified key risk factors that may negatively impact the adaptation process of Ukrainian children and their families in the Czech Republic. The study employed a review of relevant literature, a combined research strategy enabling methodological triangulation, self-constructed questionnaires, and semi-structured interviews. The findings reveal that adaptation groups play a crucial role in facilitating the integration of children into Czech society. This is primarily due to the high professionalism of caregivers and the supportive environment they provide for these children.
