Evaluation

Major criteria:

The present paper deals with the interesting topic of the Proud Boys movement. The author specifically tries to trace the processes of securitization of masculinity in Gavin McInnes' YouTube presentations. The theoretical framework is appropriately built on contemporary securitization literature combined with gender approaches. From this framework, analytical categories are derived through which empirical content is systematized. The resulting analysis is very convincing. I consider the paper to be very accomplished. However, in addition to the strengths mentioned above, I must mention one weakness, which lies in the lack of final interpretation of the results. Given the sophisticated analytical framework and systematic methodology, it is a pity that the author did not present her interesting results more clearly.
