high degree of cooperation, analysis of voting records. Student mentioned use of most popular power indexes. Student found that Benelux had high degree of voting cohesion. Supervisor gave thesis A, had clear goal, clear research design, clearly answers questions, two critiques, more argumentation would be helpful, sometimes text

not very precise in explanation of figures, that presentation is

sometimes abit confusing. Committee mentioned that second reader finds that thesis is above average, that thesis demonstrates author's strong understanding of Benelux influence in EU council. Student mentioned high degree of centralisation that is unprecedented in EU. Student mentioned draw from historical institutionalism, how

consensus building almost replace voting system. Student answered

questions from second reader, about how power indexes don't really work, that for power indexes votes are considered random, but aren't

in real life, suggest emphasise population of different states.
