Course of the examination:	The student presented the issues he dealt with in his dissertation. He dealt with educational ootentials of Post-Critical Affirmation, Non-Formal Practices and Online Technologies. According to the first reviwer the topic of the dissertation is highly relevant and the author succeeds in achieving the main goals of the dissertation. However, he mentioned some issues: what exactly are digital technologies in their thinghood? What exactly do we gain by reporting the case studies and the analyses of the other thinkers? And what does it mean to interiorize the digital technologies? Also the second oponent found the thesis innovative and dealing with a highly relevant topic, especially investigating the threat to education involved in the way digital technologies are mostly used today in contexts of teaching and learning. However, according to him, the analysis of our digital present is lacking: it seems to mix-up an analysis in terms of surveillance capitalism (a rather banal argument about monetization) with an analysis in terms of instrumentalization.
