Course of the examination: The chair of the committee greeted the student, the supervisor and the examiners as well as the members of the committee. Following this, the chair invited the supervisor to present the student and their Ph.D. studies, including the context of meeting with the student and their research (including their disciplinary background, their move across the several fields, their publications and active participations in several international conferences). The student then presented a brief summary of their dissertation, with main focus on its theme, topic, theory, methodology (including research methods and techniques used), and use of the concept of intersectionality, homonationalism, etc. The summary of the evaluation by the consultant then followed. Then, both examiners presented main points of their evaluations. After that, the student responded to the presented evaluations, especially to the questions included in them (starting with the questions posed by dr. Maryna Shevtsova, then the ones posed by doc. Petra Košťálová). The more general discussion followed (including the use of concept of queer ethnography and homonationalism) in which participated the student, the examiners, the supervisor, and the members of the committee. The non-public part of the defence was held then, including voting by the committee on grading. Then, the results of the defence were publicly disclosed.
