Summary

The master's thesis examines, on a theoretical level, the integration of specialized palliative care into senior home care and the collaboration of two entities within the Paliatr Vysočina project. The thesis is formally divided into 5 chapters and contains 13 appendices. The author specifies basic concepts of hospice and palliative care, the concept of palliative care in the Czech Republic, the Paliatr Vysočina project, and home hospice as a provider of specialized palliative care in individual chapters. They characterize the clinical profile of the senior population in residential social service facilities. The thesis also outlines the specifics of collaboration between two entities in shared care, specifically in terms of top-level, line-level, and operational management. In this context, the concluding chapters focus on multidisciplinary team and inter-agency collaboration, collaboration between healthcare and social professions, documentation management, feedback, and case supervision. The thesis topic is complemented by supportive legal institutions regarding expressing preferences for future end-of-life care within the current legal framework of the Civil Code.
