

This is the syndrome with the isotope of the pulmonary artery hypertension being for and after the pulmonary artery endarterectomy. The theoretical part of the pulmonary artery hypertension, its diagnosis, classification and cure. Special characteristics are added to the chronic embolic pulmonary artery hypertension and the pulmonary artery endarterectomy.

The research part of the syndrome includes a short-term case report and a description of the specific care about patients after the pulmonary artery endarterectomy. We evaluate the standard questionnaire SF-36 about the state of health in this part, which the patient has with the chronic embolic pulmonary artery hypertension we review it with, before and after the surgical operation, and the improvement was examined. We also investigate if the person's role in the responsibilities, as the irrigator or sex, plays an important role in the response. The patients benefit from a surgical operation of the coronary artery bypasses while reviewing the same questionnaire, and the results of both groups of patients are compared.
