

The subject of Diploma thesis „Reunification of Germany as Aim of the FRG's Policy, 1989-90“ is a description and an analysis of the key's events of unification process and attitude of Kohl's government and opposition parties in the German parliament towards German question in the 1980s and reunification of both German states after the fall of the Berlin Wall. The whole process was influenced by the policy of superpowers whose approach to the German question presented a decisive factor of the Central European development in the period in view. Regarding rights and responsibilities of the four victorious powers in Germany (USA, Soviet Union, Great Britain, France), the process had foreign policy dimension. Except this impact it is also necessary to take account of European context of unification process.

The thesis also describe to development of Germany policy (Deutschlandpolitik) of the federal governments since 1949. The unchangeable aim of government cabinet was staying unification of both German states, but their methods how achieve the objective were different. The Reasons of the dramatic events in East Germany in 1989-90, had deep roots in the past. Therefore is connected a brief development of second German state in the 1970s and 1980s.
