OVERALL ASSESSMENT (provided in English, Czech, or Slovak):

The thesis tackles the effect of common currency on trade creation empirically. It tries to revise the original findings in the literature by Andrew Rose.

This is a great thesis. Daniel shows a great undestanding of the subject. The thesis is well-executed and literature cited appropriately. It looks more like MA rather than BA thesis. The revised version has some potential to be published in a journal.

I would like to draw the attention of the author to the article by Tomas Havranek that was recently published in the Review of World Economics. The article brings a new perspective (via quantitative survey) to the literature on the effect of common currency on trade creation.

I strongly recommend the thesis for the defense and suggest grade A. I also suggest a distinction from the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences for an extraordinarily good BA thesis.
