This work describes aspects of daily life of Gypsi's community in Dobra Voda, that is socially separated from its neighborhood. The author focuses on history and social environment of this local community. He also points out his own experience with living in Dobra Voda and working with Gypsi's children, mainly boys. In conclusion he makes several suggestions, how street-workers could cooperate with Catholic Church to help children of this community to socialize within Czech majority. The author believes, the church is able to contribute positively and with cooperation with local Roma social worker could help these people to quit their social insulation.
