

The thesis deals with both published and unpublished texts which Jirina Popelova (1904 - 1985) wrote about Jan Amos Komensky.

In the introduction part there is a brief curriculum vitae of Jirina Popelova and then significance of her work in Czech Comeniological research is described. The following chapter presents relationship between Comeniological studies and the rest of her work. (She also thought and wrote e. g. about ethics or history of philosophy.)

The most extensive chapter is an analysis of single Comeniological texts focusing particularly on less known studies from 1970' s.

The conclusion is that Jirina Popelova was a researcher who changed general understanding of Jan Amos Komensky, especially comprehension of his basic writing *The General Deliberation on the Remedy of Human Matters*.
