paintings rise from 1910. Beneš sta	ands in the czech cubist movement by Emil Filla. Beneš's cubist
paintings have success in prewar Ge	ermany.

After World War I. Beneš turns away from cubism and works with Antonín Slavíček's painting reference. Subsequently he detects other fuels, he mainly finds guidance in tradition of modern

french painting. As a member of group Mánes he creates especially landscapes, still lifes and big part of his art is dedicated to Prague. These paintings are denoted as sensual realism. His expression changes in the remaining part not much.
