

Summary of the thesis “Organisation of public administration in the City of Prague“

This thesis focuses on complex issue of organisation of public administration in the City of Prague. The reason, which led author to choose this topic, is that there are only few jurists, who dedicate more than several words to this subject in their studies or articles. Therefore this subject matter isn't as explored as for example organisation of public administration in villages or counties in Czech Republic.

Aim of this thesis is to go through several sources of information from legislation, judgements and jurisprudence and provide a complex view on current legislation, which regulates organisation of public administration in the City of Prague. Author also tries to add his opinions on some sources.

At first we find some theoretical introduction to the topic and brief summary of historical development of the Prague. These facts are used in following chapters.

Main part of the thesis is in Chapter Five and Chapter Six. Chapter Five includes description of legislation, which concerned this issue since 1850. This year was not selected casually. It's year of inception of self-government in the Prague. Chapter Six describes activities of administrative bodies, which operate in the City of Prague and its boroughs.

Author emphasizing currently effective City of Prague Act (č. 131/2000 Sb.) and Charter of City of Prague (č. 55/2000 Sb. hl. m. Prahy). Problematical provisions of both regulations are investigated in detail. For some of them author outlines his view “*de lege ferenda*”. Thesis also brings consideration of radical changes of organisation of public administration in the City of Prague. These considerations are confronted with specifications of the City of Prague and its everyday reality. Author connects to these considerations their expected impacts on the lives of citizens and activities of administrative bodies.

Thesis also examines in detail issue of personality boroughs and their legal capacity. Author interprets legislation, provides view of judges and jurisprudence. On these information author tries to provide his opinion on character of boroughs.

At the end of the thesis author summarises knowledge from the whole thesis, which relates to the effective legislation. On this base author tries to judge current legislation regulating organisation of public administration in the City of Prague.
